CASE STUDY ONE

HERE'S TO HEALTHY HOMES



Safe water is essential to a healthy home. Yet Rosalie's rural Filipino home once lacked a water connection, and bathing, cooking, cleaning, and handwashing were almost impossible.

Through their work in the Philippines, Water.org helps make small, affordable loans possible for families to construct household water connections and toilets. Rosalie and her family now have access to safe water and the health and hope that flow from it.

"Now I can do so many things in my life like cook and wash dishes when I want, bathe myself and my kids...play with my daughter. Water does not control our lives anymore."








CASE STUDY TWO

HER FAMILY'S BRIGHT FUTURE STARTS WITH WATER



Sally is a mum of four young children. Even before becoming a mum, and for several years after, Sally was responsible for finding the water her family needed to survive. She spent hours of her days collecting water from a local well.

Water.org's commitment to creating lasting solutions for people in poverty changed Sally's life. Through their partnerships in the Philippines, local banks offer loans for water taps and toilets for families in need.

With a small, affordable loan Sally gave her family the water they need to survive. Now she doesn't have to pass the burden of water collection on to her children, nor will she continue to carry it alone. Her kids can go to school each day and Sally can focus on the things that matter most.

Together with Water.org, ADSM is helping to give moms like Sally, more – more health, more time, and more hope for their families. It starts with access to safe water.







CASE STUDY THREE

FROM POVERTY TO POSSIBILITY



Yolanda's home sits above the city of Cusco, Peru in the Andes Mountain range at more than 2,000 feet from the centre of town. She spent hours every other day trekking up and down the mountain to buy water for her family. The cost to construct a water tap in her home was too much to pay for all at once, until she learned of a small, affordable loan through Water.org's partner bank in Peru.

Now with lasting access to safe water at home, Yolanda can focus on her sewing business and care for her family.

Through our support of Water.org, ADSM has helped change the lives of more than 2,300 people around the world with lasting access to safe water – turning a life of poverty into a life of possibility for families like Yolanda's.







CASE STUDY FOUR

PATRICIA BUILT A LIFE SHE LOVES



Patricia once spent a few hours each day walking to and from a water source to provide water for her family. Now, her water crisis is in the past.

With a small, affordable loan through Water.org's financial partner in Kenya, Patricia installed three rain storage tanks on her property. Now she has enough water to feed her livestock, water her vegetable garden, and to cover her household needs. And, now she doesn't walk long distances carrying heavy vessels of water, multiple times a day.

We're proud to support Water.org to help create more stories of resilience and hope, made possible by affordable access to safe water.








CASE STUDY FIVE

FOR HER FARM AND FAMILY



Without water at home, Grace and her husband Joshua paid high prices for water to be drawn from a local pond and carted to their property. Through a small, affordable loan from a Water.org partner in Kenya, Grace installed a water storage tank on her farm.

With access to safe water just outside her door, Grace can feed her chickens, grow food in her garden, and use the water to cook, bathe, and do laundry. Hope, health, time, income, opportunity – safe water takes families like Grace and Joshua's from poverty to possibility.

It is for women like Grace that we support Water.org. Our donations to date have helped empower more than 2,300 people in need with lasting access to safe water or sanitation.








CASE STUDY SIX
