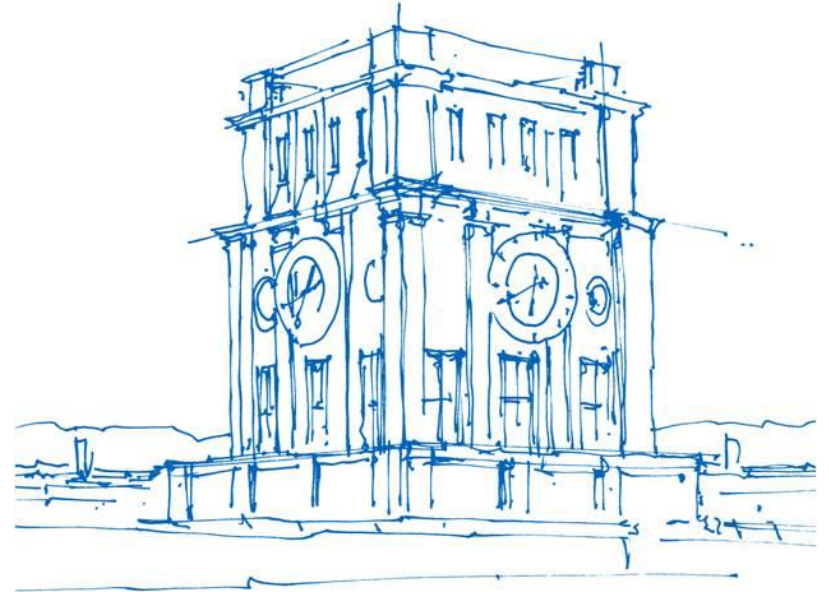

- September 2023\*: Development of **microalgae** and/or direct **solar fuel** production and purification technologies for advanced aviation and /or shipping fuels (HORIZON-CL5-2023-D3-02-08)
- April 2023\*: Accelerating climate neutral **hydrogen-powered/electrified aviation** (HORIZON-CL5-2023-D5-01-08)
- September 2023\*: Critical technologies to improve the lifetime, efficient decommissioning and increase the **circularity** of offshore and onshore wind energy systems (HORIZON-CL5-2023-D3-02-15)

## 2) EIC Pathfinder

Radically new technology, with potential to create new markets and/or to address global challenges

Early-stage (TRL1-4) breakthrough technology

Grants of up to € 3 to 4 million for a period of 3-4 years

- **Pathfinder Open** (March 2023\*) (at least 3 partners)
- **Pathfinder Challenges** (fall 2023\*) (also single or small consortia of 2)
  - Clean and efficient cooling \*
  - Novel technologies for sustainable and inclusive built environment \*
  - Responsible Electronics \*
  - In-space solar power harvesting and novel propulsion approaches \*
  - Precision Nutrition \*

Research problem so ambitious, that can not be dealt with you and your team alone

Scientific excellence + outstanding intrinsic synergetic effect

€ 10 million (up to € 14 million) for a period of 6 years

2-4 PIs of which up to **1 PI outside EU** (within the BUDGET!)

[Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft](#) | German Research Foundation **self-governing** organization for science and research

- large majority of its **funds from the federal government and the states**
- serves **all branches** of science and the humanities
- fosters **basic research** (bottom-up strategy)
- Funding programs: Individual Grants, Coordinated Programs, Excellence Initiative, Research Infrastructure, Scientific Prizes, International Programmes
- There are collaboration from DFG with UK funding organizations:

# DFG Coordinated Programmes

## **Transregio Collaborative Research Centers / TRR (s. [Link](#))**

- Goal: realizing a large-scale long-term cutting-edge fundamental research program (up to 3 funding periods 4 years each = 12 years)
- Eligibility: a consortium of ca. 15-30 PIs with at least a completed doctorate; spokesperson a full professor
- Funding for: positions for doctoral students and postdocs, direct project costs, workshops, travel expenses, infrastructure, equipment, coordination, diversity, data management, public outreach, etc.

## **International Research Training Groups / IRTG (s. [Link](#))**

- Goal: a large-scale research program complemented with an extensive qualification program for doctoral candidates (up to 4 years for a PhD, 2 funding periods of total 9 years (5+4 years))
- Eligibility: a consortium of typically 10 PIs with at least a completed doctorate; spokesperson typically a full professor
- Funding for: doctoral candidate positions and postdocs (must be justified), direct project costs, workshops, travel expenses, small-scale equipment, qualification program, coordination, diversity, etc.

# DFG Individual Funding

## Initiation of International Collaboration (s. [Link](#))

- Goal: establishing collaborative relationships between international partners (duration 12 months)
- Eligibility: typically a completed doctorate
- Funding for: workshops, research stays abroad and in Germany (up to 3 months)

## Scientific Networks (s. [Link](#))

- Goal: establishing national and international networks (10-20 researchers) by/for early career researchers in interdisciplinary and strategically important areas of research (duration 3 years)
- Eligibility: spokesperson(s) with a completed doctorate
- Funding for: travel expenses (meetings are in Germany), coordination costs, publication costs

## Individual Grants (s. [Link](#))

- Goal: conducting an individual research project with a well-defined topic (typically 3 years)
- Eligibility: a completed doctorate; position at a German university or a German university as a host
- Funding for: own position or a doctoral student position, direct project costs, workshops, travel expenses, small-scale equipment

# DFG - UK-German Funding Initiative in the Humanities



## UK-German collaborative research projects (s. [Link](#))

- Target group: This funding opportunity provides the opportunity **for UK-based arts and humanities researchers to conduct highly integrated projects with Germany-based partners**, adding value to research objectives through international collaboration.
- Objectives: Proposals may be submitted in **any area of the Humanities**. The primary aim should be **to make fundamental advances in human knowledge in the relevant fields**. Projects must have well-defined joint working programmes, **clearly demonstrating the added value of UK-German collaboration**.
- Funding: Funding for min of 24 and max. of 36 months.
- Requirements: Doctorate less than 4 years ago, family leave will be considered; min. 2 years postdoctoral experience; research experience abroad; documented scientific excellence; prepared to continue scientific career in Germany after the support
- Deadline: **Wednesday, February 15th 2023 at 23:59 hrs (German time)**
