EPSRC Early Career researcher International Funding Opportunity, 2 routes: open funding route £4M (Germany eligible for this) OR international development funding route £1M (£200K per award) deadline 18 Jan 2023 (£10M total allocated through 2025)

EPSRC has announced plans to develop new joint activities with Germany, Canada, India and Japan to share expertise, address mutual priorities and support delivery of the Integrated Review and government science and technology priorities. TBA

Wellcome Trust fund a variety of international research collaborations, including related to climate change and health.

International Science Partnerships Fund – in development, calls expected spring 2023 across UKRI councils and learned societies: UK Government has allocated ~£500 million over 3 years. Research themes are expected to be based on priority global challenge areas including climate change, transition to NetZero, clean energy, pandemic preparedness, 'One Health', antimicrobial resistance and food systems.
