



Using the Library

Membership

Staff and apprentices from NHS trusts that have agreements with Imperial College London Library can join with full or reference membership, depending on eligibility. Students on placement in those Trusts are also eligible to join.

- To apply for library membership, complete our online registration form at www.imperial.ac.uk/library/use-the-library/ membership/nhs
- As a member you can use any of our libraries
- We will provide you with a login for our PCs,
 WiFi and your library account
- If you have an honorary contract at Imperial you are already registered and can access library services using your Imperial College London ID card

Borrowing

- You can borrow up to 20 items*
- Items are issued for 3 weeks* and will be automatically renewed for up to 12 months unless they are requested by another reader
- We only charge fines for the late return of items that have been requested by another reader
- You can borrow and return or request items at any of our libraries

NHS Knowledge and Library Hub

The NHS Knowledge and Library Hub is your gateway to online resources. The Hub connects you to high-quality knowledge and evidence, including:

- journals and databases e.g. MEDLINE, CINAHL and Trip Pro
- e-books e.g. Kortext, Oxford Medicine Online and Maudsley Prescribing Guidelines
- clinical decision support resources
 e.g. NICE Guidelines, BMJ Best Practice
 and Royal Marsden Manual
- policy and management information and research

Finding articles via the Hub is easy. With one click you can get the full text or place a request if instant access is not available.
