How does it work?

To join Cyclescheme City Bike Hire:

- 3. Your employer will review your request and, if approved, we'll send you a code for 1-years Santander Cycles membership

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Q: Do I have to use the Santander Cycles bikes for commuting and work trips only?

A: No, you can use the bikes for leisure too - but the majority of trips should be work related.

Q: Can I use Cyclescheme City Bike Hire alongside standard Cyclescheme?

A: Yes, in most cases you can have a standard Cyclescheme agreement concurrently with a City Bike Hire agreement.

Q: Do I have to spread the cost over 12 months?

A: Yes, in most case you will undertake a 12-month repayment plan - employers can reduce this, but it is not the norm.
