## **RESEARCH GRANTS & FELLOWSHIPS**

**Maruf Ali** has been awarded a CRUK Senior Fellowship. This is a prestigious 6 year award that provides salaries for Maruf and his research team, and includes all consumable costs and equipment, total value above £2M.

**Alain Filloux** has been awarded a BBSRC grant for £435K. The title is: Type VI secretion in *Pseudomonas* species: bacterial competition and biocontrol, the Co-I is **Martin Buck**.

**Maggie Dallman** was awarded NC3Rs studentship for "Refinement of hematopoietic cell transplantation using optical imaging in zebrafish".

**Eoin O'Gorman** was successful in NERC's recent Highlights Topic call, with a grant (worth £1.25M), starting next month groundtruthing eDNA techniques in various marine environments (estuaries, coastal seas, and the Southern Ocean).

A new, two-year, project grant from the MRC Newton Call awarded jointly between our group in SK and the group of Dr. Kesinee Chotivanich and Prof. Nick White at Mahidol University was awarded to explore the role of Artemisinin resistance in parasite transmission. **Jake Baum** (PI-UK), Kesinee Chotivanich (Co-I Thailand), Sasithon Pukrittayakamee (Co-I Thailand), Nicholas White (Co-I Thailand). Preventing the transmission of artemisinin resistant falciparum malaria. January 2016 to December 2017.

Masahiro Ono has been awarded a BBSRC Impact Acceleration Account Funding, 15k.
