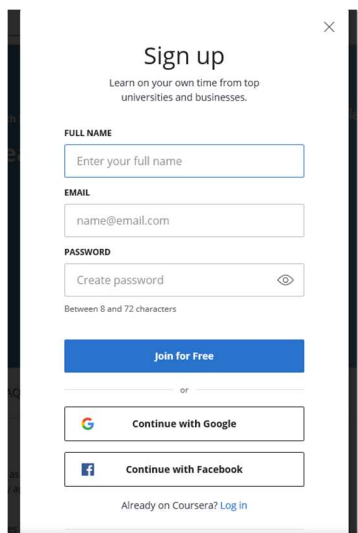
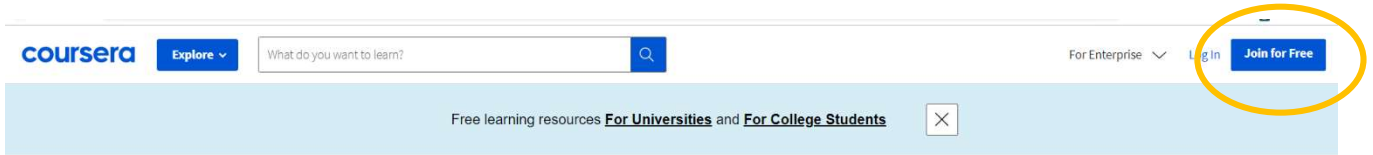


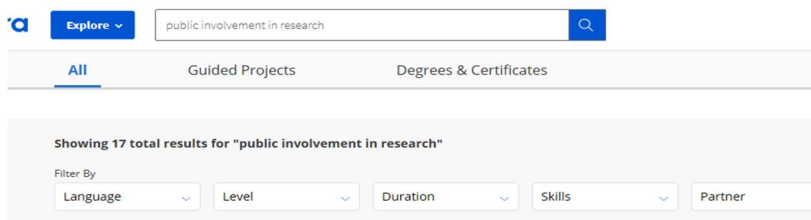
Steps to accessing the Coursera “Public Involvement in Research” online course for free (a fee will need to be paid to Coursera if you want a Certificate of Completion)

Step 1:

Create an account in Coursera using: <https://www.coursera.org/>. Click “Join for Free” in the top right hand corner and create an account.

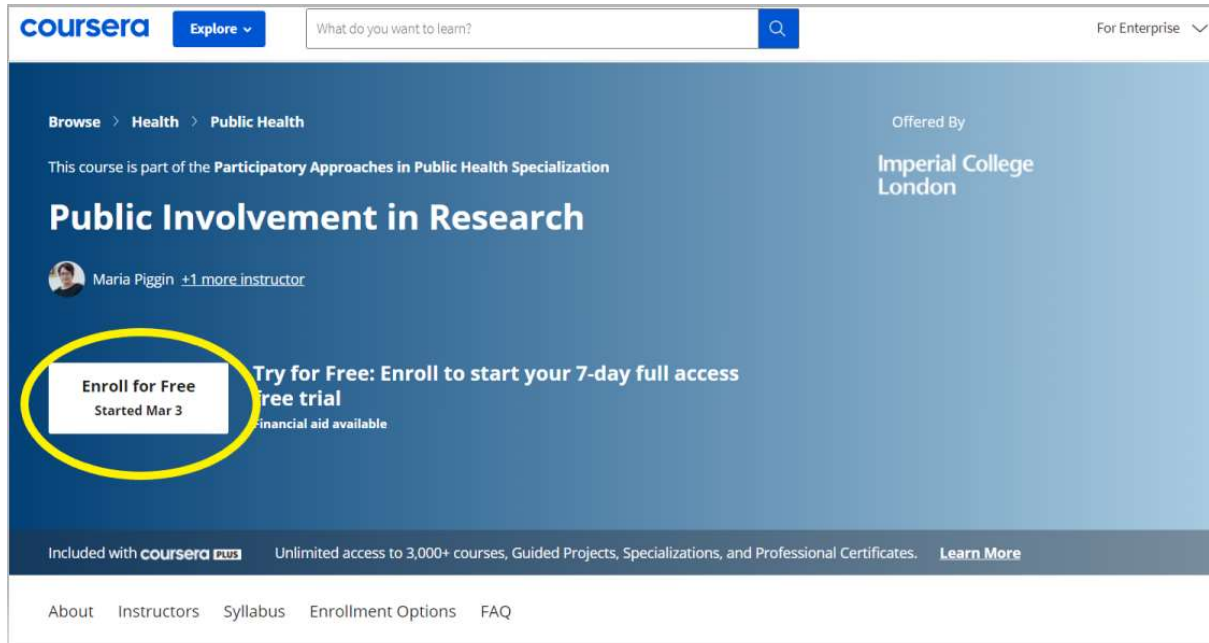


Step 2: search for “Public Involvement in Research” in the search bar at the top and click on the course. Make sure it looks like the course below and is by ‘Imperial College London’.

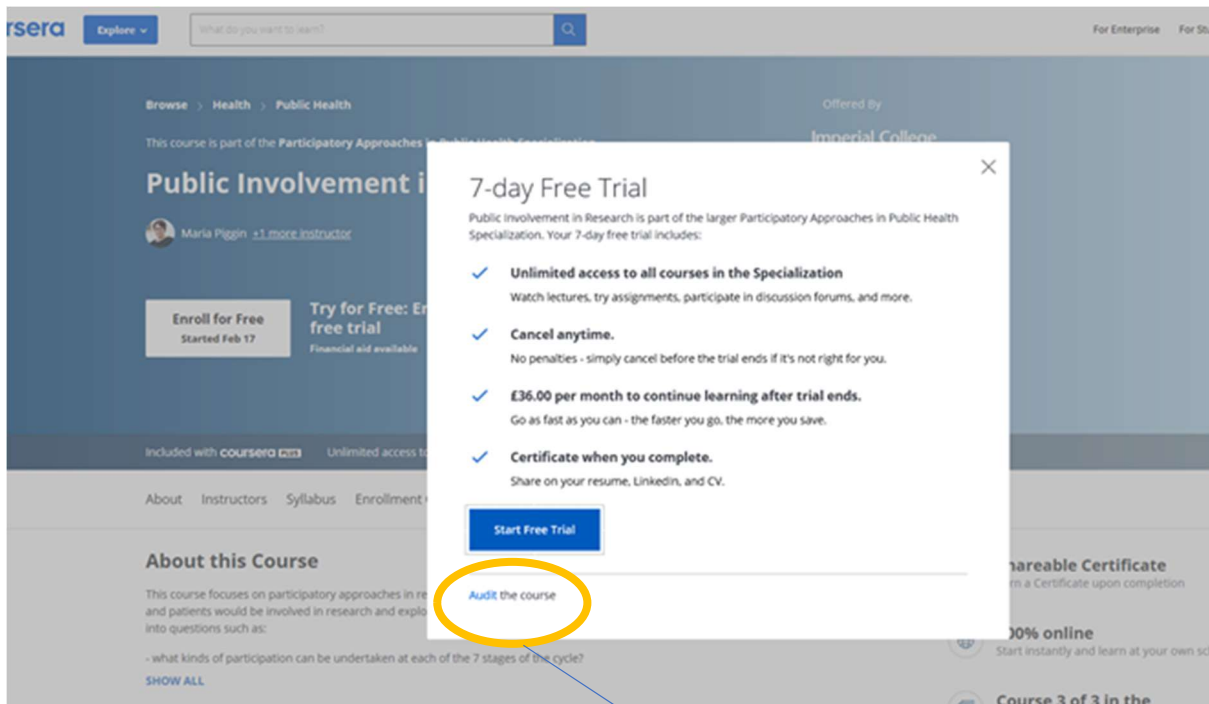


Steps to accessing the Coursera “Public Involvement in Research” online course for free (a fee will need to be paid to Coursera if you want a Certificate of Completion)
