Coursera for Campus Basic is a consortium program where by Imperial College staff and students can access MOOCs and specializations from other institutions. After joining via the steps below, learners can browse the full roster and pick any MOOCs or specializations to study for free. Learners are eligible for one free certificate per year. However, they are welcome to study on as many MOOCs or specializations as they wish.
