BEFORE You Apply


Here is a checklist of required documents you should have beforehand:

- Evidence of passing an undergraduate Bioscience module:
 - A results transcript (screenshots are accepted)
 - If you do not have this at the time of completing your application form, you must provide an academic reference from a tutor at your current institution instead.
- The College requires proof of English language qualification. Accepted proofs are:
 - Evidence of undertaking an **undergraduate or postgraduate degree** taught in English from <u>a set list of countries.</u>
 - IELTS (6.5 overall, minimum score of 6.0 in all elements)
 - TOEFL (92 overall, minimum score of 20 in all elements)
 - Other English language qualification listed on the

<u>College's English- language requirement page</u> of 'standard' level.






