

**Chevening Scholarships**  
 80% Chevening tuition fee contribution  
 20% Department tuition fee contribution  
 15 Awards

 Overseas Students

**ELIGIBLE DEPARTMENT**  
 All Departments

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENT:**

- Applicants must demonstrate that they have achieved the minimum English language requirement
- Be a citizen of a Chevening- eligible country at the time of applying for the award and intend to return there at the end of the period of study
- Hold a degree that is equivalent to at least a good UK second-class honours degree
- Received an unconditional offer to study one of the eligible courses

Student Financial Support to download the list of provisional scholars and placement forms. The placement forms will be forwarded to the Departments in **April – June 2017**.

The Departments to complete the placement forms and return to Student Financial Support if they would like to accept the students on the Chevening Scholarship and are happy to cover the 20% fee liability within 2 weeks of receiving the forms.

Student Financial Support to return the completed forms to the Chevening Secretariat

The Chevening Secretariat to inform us of their final list of scholars by **mid - end August 2017**

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENT:**

- Be Commonwealth citizens, refugees, or British protected persons
- Be permanently resident in a developing Commonwealth country
- Be available to commence their academic studies in the UK by the start of the UK academic year in September/October 2017
- Hold, by August 2017, a first degree of at least upper second class Honours standard
- Not have undertaken studies lasting one year or more in a developed country
- Be unable themselves, or through their families, to pay to study in the UK

Applicants are required to complete the Commonwealth Shared Scholarship Scheme online application form available via the Scholarships Search Tool and submit this by **27 February 2017**.

Applicants will also be required to apply via the Commonwealth Commission's EAS system by **29 March 2017**

Student Financial Support to collate the application forms and forward the eligible application forms to the the Departments above by **2 March 2017**.

The Departments to review the online applications, College application and references to assess candidates' academic merit and potential and inform Student Financial Support of their top 3 ranked candidates by **28 March 2017**.

Selection Panel to rank the top nominations and Student financial support to upload the top candidates' details to the Commonwealth Commission's EAS system by **22 April 2016**.

The Commonwealth Commission to inform Student Financial Support of the selected scholar by the end of June 2017
